



TUITION & FEES 2020 - 2021

All fees are on a per student basis. Completion of the (1) Application, (2) Enrollment Process, and (3) the payment of the Registration Fee will secure the student's position in the new school year. Tuition and Registration Fees are charged on an annual basis and are non-refundable. Tuition will be prorated for enrollment after the beginning of the school year.

SEMESTER PAYMENT PLAN

Two (2) Payments: Tuition plus \$250 Payment Plan Fee
Due by August 2019 and December 2019

EPK2/EPK3/Tran/PK4 Part Time	\$5,300 Tuition plus \$250 Plan Fee = \$ 2,775 each
EPK2/EPK3/Tran/PK4 Full Time	\$7,000 Tuition plus \$250 Plan Fee = \$ 3,625 each
Kindergarten - 5th Grade	\$8,700 Tuition plus \$250 Plan Fee = \$ 4,475 each

MONTHLY PAYMENT PLAN

Ten (10) Payments: Tuition plus \$500 Payment Plan Fee
Due each month August - May

EPK2/EPK3/Tran/PK4 Part Time	\$5,300 Tuition plus \$500 Plan Fee = \$ 580 each
EPK2/EPK3/Tran/PK4 Full Time	\$7,000 Tuition plus \$500 Plan Fee = \$ 750 each
Kindergarten - 5th Grade	\$8,700 Tuition plus \$500 Plan Fee = \$ 920 each

Payments may be made in the form of cash, check, or online bank or credit card drafts via FACTS Tuition Management. Full Payment Plans are due on August 5th, 20th, or 25th and have no associated payment plan fees. Semi-Annual Payment Plans are due on August 5th, 20th, or 25th and December 5th, 20th, or 25th and have an annual \$250 Payment Plan Fee. Monthly Payment Plans are due on the 5th, 20th, or 25th of each month and have an annual \$500 Payment Plan Fee.

ENROLLMENT FEES

Annual Registration Fee: \$450 PER STUDENT

Non-Refundable, Due at time of enrollment each year

New Student Application Fee: \$100 PER STUDENT

Non-refundable, Due one time only with application

SPECIAL PROGRAM FEES

After School Care: \$ 12.00 per day for attendance
\$ 10.00 per occurrence for late pick up after 6:00 pm. This is strictly enforced.
Excessive late pick-ups will cause the forfeiture of After School Care attendance privileges

Lunches: Daily - TBD

OTHER FEES

Convenience Fee: 3% on credit card payments for tuition and fees, if payments are made through the business office and not through FACTS. *There will not be a convenience fee for debit card transactions where pin numbers are used. There will not be a convenience fee charged for Donations or Sponsorships made to the School using a credit card. The School accepts Visa, MasterCard, or Discover.*

NSF Fee: \$25 on all returned payments

Past Due Fees: \$25 each month for past due tuition and fees

Tuition is due on the 5th, 20th, or 25th of each month. All other fees are due upon receipt of the monthly statement. Payments received after the 25th of each month are considered past due.

Any account that becomes 60 days past due will cause forfeiture of enrollment and thereby all financial aid and/or scholarships to be forfeited; all tuition and fees will become due immediately and forwarded to the collection agency with all the associated collection and legal fees charged to the account. FUTURE ENROLLMENT WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.

DISCOUNTS – NOT TO EXCEED 50% OF TUITION Kindergarten – 5th Grade ONLY

Tuition Remission: Up to 50% Kindergarten - 5th Grade, Based on Financial Need

- Application for Tuition Remission is available on a first-come first-served basis annually.
- Tuition Remission is awarded according to financial need and to the extent of available tuition remission funds.
- Maximum tuition remission/discount/scholarship allowed is 50%.

TUITION ACTIVE MILITARY DISCOUNT: 20% Kindergarten-5th grade

Definition for “Active Military” for Military Discount:

- **The child has a parent or official guardian that is an active duty member of the Armed Forces of the United States**, including the state military forces or a reserved component of the armed forces, **who is ordered to active duty** by proper authority. This includes uniformed service members who are Missing in Action (MIA).

ST. JOHN'S TUITION & FEES 2020 – 2021 Continued

- **The child has a parent or official guardian that is a member of the Armed Forces of the United States, including the state military forces or a reserved component of the armed forces is serving on active duty.** The term “member of the armed forces” includes: active duty uniformed members (parents or official guardians) of the Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force, or Coast Guard who are assigned to duty stations in Texas or who are Texans who have eligible children residing in Texas; activated/ mobilized uniformed members of the Texas National Guard (Army or Air Guard), or activated/mobilized members of the Reserve components of the Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force, or Coast Guard who are Texas residents regardless of the location of the reserve unit; and uniformed service members who are Missing In Action (MIA).
- **Active duty military participation will require the following documents:** Department of Defense Identification and a Statement of Service from the Adjutant General/ Director of Human Resources or an official letter from a commander that he/she is active and/or mobilized.

RE-ENROLLMENT BONUS DISCOUNT: \$350 WITH CONDITIONS

- Available to the year's **currently enrolled PK4 – 4th grade** students who are re-enrolled in the subsequent school year in the K-5th grades
- **Re-enrollment application form(s) and registration fee(s) must be completed and paid on or before the first school day of April each year**
- Student(s) receiving discount must complete the entire school year unless proration is authorized by the Head of School
- Cannot be combined with financial aid or staff discount to exceed the 50% cap on tuition abatement
- Can be combined with scholarships awarded to student(s) as long as the 50% cap on tuition abatement is not exceeded
- Applied to qualifying families' account(s) on the same schedule as the tuition payment plan chosen (Annual, Semester, or Monthly)
- Discount subject to available funds and is not guaranteed in future years

SCHOLARSHIPS

- **Must be re-enrolled to be eligible for nomination**
- Nominated by classroom teachers and enrichment teachers
- Scholarships awarded each May for the next school year
